

We are thrilled to introduce a brand-new experience for our children—the Light & Shadow Room! This special space is designed to spark curiosity, creativity, and sensory exploration in a fun and engaging way.

What's Inside the Light & Shadow Room?





Shadow Exploration with Immersive Projector Displays

Our projector transforms the room into different magical settings—a galaxy, a forest, or even a bright blue sky-aligned with our learning themes. This feature encourages children to immerse themselves in storytelling, dramatic play, and discussions about nature, space, and the world around them.


Children can also see their shadows come to life in the dark! By moving, dancing, and interacting with the light, they begin to understand how light and shadow work together. This hands-on experience fosters body awareness, coordination, and early scientific thinking as they experiment with movement and its effects.















Overhead Projector (OHP)

With our Overhead Projector (OHP), children can explore how objects create shadows by placing various items—pebbles, leaves, animal figurines, and more—on the OHP glass. These objects are then projected onto the wall, encouraging experimentation with size, shape, and layering. This activity enhances problemsolving skills, creativity, and fine motor development.





Loose Parts Exploration

To encourage open-ended play, we provide a variety of loose parts such as magnetic tiles, flashlights, shadow puppets, tissue rolls, bark, pinecones, and other natural materials. These materials allow children to build, design, and explore different shadow formations, boosting their imagination and critical thinking skills.

Light Table Sensory Play

The light table offers a hands-on sensory experience where children can observe the movement of glitter, oil, and water. This enhances their fine motor skills and understanding of scientific concepts such as viscosity, transparency, and motion.



















Glow-in-the-Dark Painting

One of the most exciting features! In this special dark corner covered with black cloth, children can explore neon colors under blue light, experiment with glow-in-the-dark paints, and create luminous art. This activity encourages artistic expression, sensory awareness, and visual perception, making learning both fun and visually stimulating. Our Light & Shadow Room is a place where learning meets wonder, where science and art blend seamlessly, and where every child's curiosity is sparked in an unforgettable way. We can't wait to see the magic unfold as children explore this unique space!

CELEBRATING DENTAL DAY

AT ALAM ATELIER!

On February 21, 2025, our Alam Atelier community came together for a special event -Dental Day! In collaboration with Smart Dental, this day was dedicated to raising awareness about dental health among our children. We were honored to have a team of friendly dentists from Smart Dental visit us, conducting check-ups and engaging our little learners in an interactive and educational session on oral hygiene.

In the weeks leading up to Dental Day, our classrooms were buzzing with excitement as we introduced a dental-themed provocation table. This hands-on setup sparked curiosity and helped familiarize children with the concept of dental care. Through books, models, and role-playing as dentists, they explored the importance of keeping their teeth clean. This preparation not only eased any apprehension about the checkup but also cultivated their sense of belonging, as they actively participated in discussions and play that connected to real-life experiences.

The event kicked off in our library with dental check-ups. Our children waited eagerly for their turn, displaying courage and confidence as they opened their mouths wide for examination. The dentists from Smart Dental were incredibly kind and engaging, making the experience smooth and enjoyable. Through this process, the children learned about responsibility for their personal hygiene, building their independence and self-awareness-important life skills that extend beyond dental care.













After the check-ups, we gathered in the Pendopo for an interactive dental hygiene education session. The Smart Dental team captivated our young learners with a fun and informative presentation, emphasizing the importance of brushing twice a day. They demonstrated the correct circular brushing technique and explained how choosing the right toothpaste helps protect teeth and gums. Through songs and dances, learning became joyful and memorable, reinforcing fine motor skills, coordination, and active listening.

Following the presentation, children engaged in a variety of hands-on activities designed to deepen their understanding of oral care. Our Pre-Nursery friends explored playdough teeth, shaping gums and teeth to develop their pincer grip and motor skills while gaining an understanding of dental anatomy. Meanwhile, our Nursery friends took to the deck, brushing giant model teeth with white paint representing toothpaste. This process-art activity not only encouraged creativity but also reinforced the importance of proper brushing techniques.

Our Kinder and Prep friends participated in a provocation activity that challenged them to clean 'plague' and food particles from model teeth using toothbrushes. This engaging task helped develop their problem-solving skills and understanding of cause and effect—essential scientific thinking. Additionally, it nurtured their patience, perseverance, and fine motor coordination.

At the end of the day, each child received a certificate, a dental card, and a thoughtful goodie bag filled with a toothbrush and toiletries from Smart Dental—a wonderful reward for their bravery and enthusiasm. This event was a testament to our shared commitment to holistic education, where real-life experiences are interwoven with learning, fostering lifelong skills and character development.

MOSQUITO PREVENTION AND APPLICATION AT ALAM ATELIER JAKARTA

Dear Alam Atelier Families,

Living in Jakarta means coexisting with a large mosquito population and other insects, especially in natural outdoor spaces. We understand that this can be a health concern and may create a sense of unease. That's why we have multiple measures in place to ensure the safety and comfort of our students while maintaining a balanced, ecofriendly approach.

To naturally deter mosquitoes, our garden is filled with carefully maintained plants such as lemongrass, mint, rosemary, periwinkle, and thyme. Our dedicated gardeners tend to these plants every weekend to keep them thriving.

In addition to natural deterrents, we conduct weekly fogging to eliminate mosquito larvae and nests, effectively reducing insect populations. Our ponds are drained daily and thoroughly cleaned each week, and we also use a safe, eco-friendly product to prevent mosquito larvae, black flies, and other pests from developing in standing water.

Before heading outdoors, all students are provided with a gentle, non-toxic bug spray imported from Bali, ensuring protection without harsh chemicals. Within our classrooms and throughout the school, diffusers release natural insect-repelling scents like lavender, lemongrass, and eucalyptus to further enhance our protective efforts.

We prioritize the safety of children, families, and teachers and are always open to feedback and improvements. While we take every precaution to protect everyone from insects, we also recognize that the garden is their natural habitat. Our goal is to maintain a balanced approach—managing insect populations while respecting the environment—so that students can enjoy and explore the outdoor space safely
